## **LEVEL 4 - PARENTING GROUP TP FALL SESSION (6-12 YEARS OLD) MUST BE REGISTERED TO ATTEND**

### **WHAT IS GROUP TRIPLE P?**

Group Triple P is a parenting intervention in which parents actively participate in a range of exercises to learn about the causes of child behavior problems, set specific goals, and use strategies to manage misbehavior. This program consists of five (two-hour) group sessions and three (15 to 30 minute) individual (telephone) consultations to assist parents with independent problem solving while they are practicing the skills at home.

### **WHO IS IT FOR?**

This class is designed for parents or caregivers of children ages 6-12 who have concerns about their child's behavior. Parents need to be able to commit to at least four of the group sessions.

### **WHAT IS COVERED IN SESSIONS WITH PARENTS?**

Session 1: Positive parenting

Session 2: Helping Children Develop

Session 3: Managing Misbehavior

Session 4: Planning Ahead

Session 5: Program Close
